Dear Miss Gullicksen

I cannot now answer your questions about my new book because I have yet to hear from the publisher who is considering it. I would prefer not to need another private printing, for these are a tremendous amount of extra work and the two of us are already overtaxed. It cannot, also, be profitable.

However, if a private printing is necessary we are prepared to go ahead with it, and soon. Until then I cannot and do not know the price. It cannot be less than \$4.95, for it is a larger book. I hope it will not have to be more than that, possibly \$5.30 or \$5.95. Until we know and can take it to the printer for estimates, there is little further I can say.

We have heard from a number of people about it. Some ask us to send it when it is available and we have set up a file for this purpose. If you would like us to do this, we will. On the price, all I can say is that it will not be higher than \$5.95. If possible we'll keep it at \$4.95.

Thanks, also, for the thoughtfulness of the return-addressed envelope. A very little bit of time saved means that much more I can do.
