2. I have no reason to believe Bradley or Brading are relevant.
3. During Garrison days I tried to keep him in contact with reality, failed too often, and for this have regrets.
4. I would like to know your source, and I suspect I can guess it, for saying that there is a "newly released FBI document that shows the FBI received a bullet from Dr. J. J. Fumes." I obtained this as a result of much effort years ago and published it in POST MORTEM. It does not say what you say and I do not know what it refers to. Those who see personal benefit in exaggeration and also claim credit for work they do not do generally misuse information this way.
5. You are on our mailing list and we will let you know if and when we publish anything else.
