WASHINGTON — Congress was urged Thursday to investigate thoroughly the F.B.I. to assure its members that J. Edgar Hoover's agents were not eavesdropping on them, as House Democratic leader Hale Boggs has charged. In addition, Rep. Wayne Hays (D-Ohio) announced plans for hiring an electronics firm to check Congressional phones for wiretapping, while another Congressman, Rep. John Rooney (D-N.Y.) revealed that Hoover testified three weeks ago that from 1924 to the present the FBI had never conducted such wiretaps.
