MISCELLANEOUS-INFORMATION CONCERNING

At 3:16 p.m., 6/3/75, Supervisor [REDACTED] BING, telephone (202) 324-4192, called stating he has been assigned to review a book written by GEORGE O'TOOLE that involves O'TOOLE's analysis of tape recordings made incidental to the assassination matter. He stated O'TOOLE makes a discussion of a tape in which OSWALD denied he had assassinated former President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY. In this regard, [REDACTED] wanted to know if OSWALD was ever charged with the murder of KENNEDY.

At 4:29 p.m., 6/3/75, [REDACTED] all was returned, at which time he was told OSWALD was charged with the murder of President KENNEDY and at that time the contents of page 400 of 89-43-1768, were read to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] expressed his appreciation for the action afforded his request.
