

Hoffa Car Bugged

CHICAGO — Two FBI agents testified in Federal Court that they eavesdropped on Teamster President James R. Hoffa's telephone calls from his automobile by means of FM radio.

Hoffa is serving a Federal prison term for tampering with a jury and faces a consecutive term for conspiring to divert \$1 million from Teamster pension funds.

The hearing is the second granted Hoffa in two years by the Supreme Court to determine whether illegal electronic surveillance played a part in his 1964 conviction.
