CHICAGO Two FBI agents testified in Federal Court that they eavesdropped on Teamster President Language Hoffers told

dropped on Teamster President James R. Hoffa's telephone calls from his automobile by means of FM radio.

Hoffa is serving a Federal prison term for tampering with a jury and faces a consecutive term for conspiring to divert \$1 million from Teamster pension funds.

The hearing is the second granted Hoffa in two years by the Supreme Court to determine whether illegal electronic surveillance played a part in his 1964 conviction.
