'Bug' Ruling Delay
CHICAGO — A Federal
judge put off until autumn
his ruling on the legality of
the Government conducting
electronic surveillance of
domestic organizations in

the interest of national security.

Judge Julius J. Hoffman of U.S. District Court said he would conduct a hearing on the question after the jury trial of eight demonstration leaders charged with conspiring to incite a riot during Democratic National Convention week in 1968.

The trial is scheduled to start Sept. 24.
