Damages Sought Against FBI

Targets of allegedly illegal FBI break-ins and wiretaps are suing the federal government for \$100 million in damages in U.S. District Court in Manhattan.

The plaintiffs include persons named as victims of break-ins in the criminal indictment of former FBI officials L. Patrick Gray III, W. Mark Felt and Edward S. Miller, and of wiretaps and mail openings in the since-dismissed indictment of former FBI supervisor John J. Kearney.

The suit contends that the government activities included plans to kidnap the daughter of Jennifer Dohrn, sister of a leader of the radical Weather Underground.
