The Springfield Office has advised that they have obtained, through contact at the Western Cartridge Corporation, East Alton, Illinois, copies of that Corporation's records relating to the manufacture of this remunition. Western manufactured four million rounds of this amaunition for the United States Marine Corps Guring 1954. Attached is r two-prge copy of the records of Jestern relating to the complete manufacture of this order of admunition which was suthorized under Covarament contract DA-2:-196-ORD-27. The interesting thing about this order is that it is for ammunition which does not fit and cannot be fired in say of the USMC weapons. This gives rise to the obvious speculation that it is a contract for amaunition placed by CIA with Festern under a USMC cover for concealment purposes.
