Dear Mr. Rowley:

2-16-67 delivered to Warren Commission

Thank you for your letter dated February 13, 1967, advising me of your discussion with Chief Justice Earl Warren on January 31, 1967, and the information he furnished to you.

In connection with the allegation that a Castro conspiracy was involved in the assassination of President Kennedy, our investigation uncovered no evidence indicating Fidel Castro or officials of the Cuban Government were involved with Lee Harvey Oswald in the assassination of President Kennedy.

This Bureau is not conducting any investigation regarding this matter. However, should Mr. Pearson, Mr. Morgan, or Mr. Morgan's source of information care to volunteer any information to this Bureau, it would be accepted. Thereafter, consideration would be given as to whether any additional investigation is warranted.

I am taking the liberty of furnishing a copy of your letter and my reply to you to the Acting Attorney General.

Re memorandum M. A. Jones to Mr. Wick, dated 2/14/67, advising of the TV broadcast on 2/18/67, concerning the Warren Commission report.

In connection with the monitoring of this broadcast, it is suggested that the Laboratory make arrangements to tape the broadcast and thereafter representatives of the Domestic Intelligence Division, Laboratory Division, and General Investigative Division will review the material in connection with their special interests. The General Investigative Division will coordinate the over-all review of the program and will prepare a memorandum following consultation with representatives of the other Divisions who will monitor it.
