Bufile 105-104340 discloses Ferrie, born 3-28-18, Cleveland, Ohio, has been very active in the Cuban Revolutionary Front, New Orleans, Louistann, has possessed firearms and other equipment in his Hetniric, Louisiana, home and that he was interviewed by Pureau Agents on 8-22-61. Interview and background information developed strongly suggests that Ferrie, a former Eastern Airlines pilot, is a "crackpot," a description used by acquaintances to describe Ferrie. A preliminary Bureau investigation under a possible Neutrality Act character failed to indicate the existence of any neutrality matter violation by Ferrie.

Bufile 87-52503 reveals Forrie was interviewod 9-29-60, claims be was svindled out of \$2,500 in connection with p mining operation in British Honduras. 67 / 1
