"HANK KILLAM, whose wife (WANDA KILLAM) sold cigarettes and stripped for JACK RUBY in Dallas infamous Carousel Club, was found dead, his jugular vein cut, admidst shattered glass on downtown streets of Pensacola on 3/17/64.

"Police listed the death as 'Possible spicide'.

"Either for real or fantasy reasons, HANK KILLAM, whose wife had a 15 year association with JACK RUBY, began to feel their past working relationship was causing persecution.

"Too, KILLAM knew JOHN, CARTER, who had lived with LEE OSWALD in Mrs. A. C. JOHNSON'S Dallas Rooming House. He painted a few houses with CARTER-these two links being the only traceable ones connecting KILLAM to either RUBY or OSWALD.

"But men he described as 'Federal Agents' visited him repeatedly after the assassination, he lost one job after another and he attributed this to the interrogations. He said that the men never showed identification.

"So did his wife, Wanda. KILLAM even left Dallas for Florida.

"But the 'Agents' browbeat his wife into telling them where he was, she said. 'Florida', Wanda reportedly told them."

The article continues to give some background information regarding KILLAM, to the effect that Escambia County Coroner, Pensacola, Fla., after KILLAM's death reported that KILLAM apparently died of a 3 deep laceration over the left side of his neck. The death was ruled accidental.

On 2/23/67, SMYTH R. GILL (NA), Investigator, County Solicitor's Office, Pensacola, Fla., advised that County Solicitor CARL HARPER on 2/22/67, had been contacted by

deceased's brother, EARLE J. KILLAM, after the brother had read an article regarding District Attorney JIM GARRISON's investigation in New Orleans concerning the assassination of President KENNEDY. EARLE J. KILLAM requested that the body of the deceased by exhumed and an autopsy performed to determine exact reason for death, inasmuch as the deceased knew the above mentioned JOHN CARTER and deceased's wife, WANDA, had known JACK RUBY.

Mr. GILL stated he had previously known the deceased HENRY THOMAS KILLAM, white male, born 9/20/22, Pensacola, Fla., for a number of years, and related that on 5/12/58, the deceased was arrested by local authorities on charges of B & E and GL. On 10/23/58, deceased entered plea of guilty to charges and was placed on 7 years probation. Shortly after being placed on probation, deceased absconded; however, turned himself in to local authorities on or about 12/6/63.

Mr. GILL continued that after deceased turned himself in, deceased was continued on probation. Mr. GILL advised that at the present time Solicitor HARPER is in the process of making inquiries to determine if there is any reasonable ground to exhume deceased's body and conduct an autopsy; however, at the present time Mr. HARPER does not believe there is sufficient ground or reason for such action.

Newspaper clipping being forwarded to Bureau for information, and this matter will be followed closely with County Solicitor's Office, Pensacola, Fla., and Bureau will be advised of any pertinent developments.
