SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY,
11/22/63; AFO

At 5:40 PM today ASAC WILLIAM WELTE, Chicago Office, called and stated that BRYCE MILLER of UPI was putting out the story that on the day of the assassination of President KENNEDY, a man in a business suit dashed in (the hospital). A Secret Service man caught him with an uppercut, slammed him back against the wall and he slowly slid to the floor unconscious. A second later, still dazed, he reached for his wallet and stated, "I've got to call HOOVER" he said, flashing his FBI credentials.

ASAC WELTE was advised that we had the information regarding the above incident, and that there was nothing to it, that naturally there was a lot of confusion immediately following the shooting, and that apparently BRYCE MILLER was trying to drum up a story.
