Supv. GEORGE BENJAMIN, Div. VI, was telephonically contacted at 8:40 PM and advised that the roll of 8 mm film furnished to the Bu for reproduction on 11/22/63, must be returned to Dallas tonight. He was advised that Secret Service had furnished this film and must have it tomorrow morning for a show-up.

Mr. BENJAMIN advised that he is not thoroughly familiar with it; however, he feels that due to the type of film it was necessary that it be produced commercially and he does not know if all action has been taken.

He was requested to advise us telephonically what action had been taken so that further steps to return film could be put into effect.

At approximately 9:35 PM, Mr. BENJAMIN advised the film will be sent via American Airlines Flight 691, leaving Washington at 2:50 AM, 11/26/63, due to arrive at Dallas, 5:45 AM. An Agent should contact the Captain.

Mr. BENJAMIN later advised the film would be sent wia Braniff Airlines instead of American and would arrive in Dallas, 3:21 AM.
