THE NEW ORLEANS STATES ITEM, FINAL EDITION FOR MAY SIXTEEN INSTANT, CARRIED A LEAD ARTICLE WHICH STATES THAT DA JIM GARRISON ACCUSED THE U.S. ATTORNEY GENERAL OF ATTEMPTING TO USURP THE POWER OF COURTS TO DECIDE WHO WILL AND WILL NOT TESTIFY BEFORE CRAND JURY. THE ARTICLE MOTED THIS CHARGE WAS MADE IM ANSWER TO A U.S. GOVERNMENT MOVE TO PREVENT 34 REGIS KTYNEDY FROM TESTIFYING IN THE DA'S INVESTIGATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION. THE ARTICLE ALSO NOTED THAT SA KENNEDY HAD BEEN SUBPOEMAED TO TESTIFY LAST WEEK BUT THE USA HAD FILED A MOTION TO DISMISS THE CALL FOR TESTIFYING BY THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT EXECUTIVE ORDER.

THE ARTICLE ADVISED THAT THERE WERE NO ORAL ARGUMENTS TODAY DEFORE CRIMINAL DISTRICT JUDGE BERNARD J. BAGERT BY EITHER THE DA'S OFFICE OR THE U.S. COVERMMENT ATTORNEYS. THE ARTICLE SAID THAT JUDGE BAGERT HAD SET A FORMAL HEARING FOR TEM AM, MAY SEVENTEEN, SIXTYSEVEN AND THAT ACCRDING TO THE ATTORNEYS REPRESENTING THE U.S. SOVERNIENT, VENNEDY WOULD APPEAR AND TESTIFY IF THE JUDGE ORDERS HIN TO.

THE ARTICLE CONTINUED THAT GARRISON'S OFFICE HAS CLAIMED THAT THE U.S. ATTORNEY GENERAL HAS NOT SHOWED HE IS CLAIRVOYANT AND GIFTED WITH THE POWER OF PROPHECY AND THAT HE IS WITHOUT JUSTIFICATION OR AUTHORITY TO PREDICT THE QUESTIONS TO BE PRONOUNCED TO SA KENNEDY BY THE ORLEANS PARISH GRAND JURY.

THE ARTICLE ALSO NOTED THAT THE ATTORNEYS FOR THE GOVERN-MENT IN AN AMENDMENT TO THEIR MOTION HAD FILED CLIPPINGS FROM LOCAL NEWSPAPERS WHICH THEY SAID ALLEGED THAT KENNEDY WOULD BE QUESTIONED ABOUTH "THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY". END PAGE TWO 23.47 ISSN

THE ARTICLE ALSO STATED THAT ACCORDING TO A STATEMENT RELEASED BY THE CIVIL LIDERTIED WHOM OF LOUISIAMA (CLU) THE CLU CRITICIZED GARRISON AND AUTHORS JANES PHOLEN, HARQLD WEISBERG AND MARK LAME, WHO HAD FIGURED IN THE CASE. THE CLU IN ITS STATEMENT SAID IT BELIEVED THAT THE RIGHT OF CLAY SHAW, ACCUSED PRESIDENTIAL ASSASSIM, TO A FAIR TRIAL IS SERIOUSLY IN DANGER. THE CLU POINTED TO RECENT STATE-MENTS BY GARRISON IN WHICH GARRISON HAS ACCUSED CIA AND THE FBI OF COVERING UP THE FACTS OF THE ASSASSIMATION.

THE ARTICLE ALSO SAID THAT LA. ATTORNEY GENERAL JACK P. GREWILLION IN WASHINGTON, D.C. HAD ANNOUNCED THAT HE KNOWS NUTHING ABOUT A TAPE RECORDING OF AN ALLEGED BRIDE ATTEMPT CHARGED TO THE DA'S OFFICE BY BURTON KLEIN, ATTORNEY FOR ALVIN BEADBOEUF, ONE TIME ROOMMATE OF DAVID FERRIE. KLEIN IS ALLEGED TO HAVE SAID THAT HE IS SENDING A TAPE RECORDING OF THE BRIDE ATTEMPT TO GREMILLION.

THE ARTICLE CONCLUDED THAT THE ORLEANS PARISH GRAND JURY IS SCHEDULED TO RECEIVE ON MAY SEVENTEEN, SIXIYSEVEN, A RETURM OF A SUPPORMA DELIVERED LAST WEEK TO CIA DIRECTOR END PAGE THREE PAGE FOUR

Harold Weisberg, author of the Whitewish series of books critical of the Warren Commission investigation of the Kennedy assassination, is in New Orieans this week to publicize his fourth book on the subject.

The new volume, "Oswald in New Orleans-Case for Con-spiracy with the CIA", begins with a foreword written by District Attorney Jim Garrison, who is conducting a probe of the late President Kennedy's murder in Dallas Nov. 22, 1953. At a press conference here yesterday, Weisberg said that he leas the members of the commission were "victimized" by the type of evidence presented to them.

He sold he agrees with Garrison's theory that the assassination was planned and carried out by a small group of anti-Castro Cuban guerilias. He also said that he believes Lee Harvey Oswald did not shoot anyone in Dallas. Osweld was named the lone assassin by the Warren Commission.

Weisberg's new book deals with many of the persons who, names have been connected with Garrison's proba-Weicherg-wald it is not yet available in New Orl case
