Re Eureau mirtel to New Orleans, Dallas, Pertland and Minneapolis dated 12/1570, which dealt with a letter from MAROLD WHEDERG to the Department of Justice. The portion of MMISHARG's letter involving the Fortland Division concerned Mr. and Mrs. J. PAT DO DE and son JII, and their friends, Mr. and Mrs. MAT WILSON of Portland.

The situation involving the DOYLES and WILSONS was first outlined by Fortland in an airtel to the Eureau dated 11/27/63 captioned "JACK LEON NUEY, aka Jack Ruben Stein; LED HENVEY COUALD, aka Alek J. Hidell, G.H. Lee - VICTIM, CIVIL RIGHTS." A roll of 8 mm rotion picture film, in color, which included photos of an individual possibly LEE HARVEY CSWALD, was forwarded to the Eureau with that airtel. The film was taken by young JEI DOYLE, then 14 years old. The film was provided to the Forkland Division by the father, J. PAT DOYLE, 1107 S.T. 123rd Avenue, Partland, with the request that it be returned to him after the Eureau had kept it as long as necessary. The film was forwarded in order that the Eureau might make copies of the pertinent scenes if it so desired.

These FD-302's were set out in Portland report dated 12/1/63 in the matter entitled "LEE HARVEY OSWALD, IS - R," 12 copies of which were forwarded to the Eureau (Dufile 105-82555). Mention of the film was also made in the administrative page of that report.

By airtel to Portland dated 1/31/64 the Bureau returned the above film to Portland with the comment that the Bureau had no further need for this film, and that the film was enclosed for return to J. PAT DOYLE.

The film was returned to DOYLE on 3/10/64.


