

JFK assassination records appeals, Dallas

In the Dallas Commission file, 62-3568 there is a copy of a lengthy article by Richard Popkin. He later expanded it into a book of the same title, "The Second Oswald." As of the time of the article it was priced as a review of Epstein's Inquest and the first of my Whitewash series. In this file it is in Volume 1 as 131. Because of the length and difficulty of copying I do not attach a copy.

This is not the Dallas record copy, which clearly is filed elsewhere. Also, it was not provided by Dallas in its response to my P.A. request.

In prior appeals I have informed you that Dallas kept files on the various ^{critics} ~~criticisms~~ of the official account of the assassination and that other field offices provided records for these files. In some instances I provided file numbers.

All such files are within my assassination request.

All records of this nature relating to me are also within my P.A. request.

That the Popkin New York Review article of the 7/28/66 ^{issue} ~~issue~~ is not the record copy bears on these matters.
