At a news conference at the bar's headquarters, George M. Hasen, chairman of the committee, said there was evidence that, over a long period of time, senior officials in the CIA and FBI were involved in activities which violated statutory law and the constitutional rights

of American citizens.

Among these, he said, were the use of wiretaps and infiltration of such organizations of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference.
