Lawyers Ask Removal of Nixon As a Defendant

As a Defendant SAN DIEGO, June 2 (AP) A government attorney and one representing former President Nixon argued today that Nixon should be elimi-nated as a defendant in a 30 million lawsuit. The U.S. District Court suit was filed by Peter Boh-mer and, Paula Tharp, self-described redical activists, against Nixon and 57 other persons. It said Bohmer and Tharp were harassed, intimi-dated and injured by the government. Attorney R. Stan Morten-sen and assistant U.S. At-torney John Neece argued that a person acting in the official capacity of President of the United States is im-mune from suits.
