Post 822/14 Sweeping Rules To Safeguard **Privacy** Urged

Associated Press A group of House Repub-licans yesterday recommended sweeping guidelines to safe-guard personal privacy, in-cluding a restriction on the use of Social Security num-bers as a form of universal identification. The GOP Task Force on Pri-vacy, chaired by Rep. Barry M. Goldwater Jr. (R-Ariz.) said the Social Security number's "growing use as an identifier and filing number already is having a negative, dehumaniz-ing effect upon many citi-zens."

The group recommended repeal on any executive orders al-lowing federal agencies to use Social Security numbers and passage of legislation setting guideline for use of such numbers, by others.
