ASSASSINATION OF FRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KUNNEDY NOVEMBER 22, 1963 /PALLAS, TEXAS

Carles Bringster, New Orleans delegate to the Cuban Student Directorate (OSD), appeared in the New Crleans Office of the FBI on Cotober 10, 1968, and furnished the following information:

He advised that he was visited by afternoon of Cotober 9, 1968. She furnished her Address as Louisiana State University in Now Orleans, louisiana, 70122. advised Byinguier that she had approximately two received a letter from weeks ago. is presently in the United States military stationed in his letter to transmit a reseage for him to Carlos Brigatier. advised that he had been contacted by Harold Wylsberg, author of the stationed, book, "WHITE AEH," who has been assisying New Crieans District Attorney Johns Corrison in his investigation of the assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy. | did not advise as to what method Weisberg had used in contacting him. be subpostated by the New Orleans Grand Jury through the efforts of District Attorney Garrison of he did not state that he had previously been hired by Carlos Bringeier and that he, Bringuier, end some other Cubars had gone to a training camp for Cubars in the war Colores area. Weisborg added that if courtly with this request he would be indicted by the Orleans Parish Grand Jury for perjury.

Bringuier advised that he told; to write and tell him to go shead and testify before the Orleans Farish Grand Jury and rall the truth. Burretter and that he first met ___) in 1963 when ___ , who was of him the cool age, came into his store, the Casa Roca, 167 Decatur Street, New Orleans, to inquire about what he might do to assist in any anti-Castro activity. Bringuier stated that he gave some material to read and at one time gave him some bonds to sell from which the revenue would be used to support anti-Fidel Castro activities. Bringuler stated receive a commission for selling these bonds and was not employed by him. discontinued the sale of bonds as he claimed he was stopped by an officer, not identified, who stated he could not sell these bonds without a permit. Bringuier related that he again saw. on August 5, 1963, at the Casa Roca. was again interested in discussing anti-Castro activity and was accompanied by a companion. While Bringuier, Geraci and his companion were talking, Lee Harvey Oswald entered the Casa Roca and showed interest in joining the CSD and in obtaining as much information as possible concerning this organization's activities. Bringular advised that he excused himself at this time to make a deposit in the bank and left his companion and Oswald talking. Bringuler added that he has only seen. once since August 5, 1963, and this was at a showing of Vietnam films in the New World Theater at 1117 Decatur Street in New Orleans in 1966 or 1967.
