SOG, called stating the Burcau was in receipt of a letter from HAPOLD WISEPS, author of the book "White Wash", (a critical account of the investigation into the assassination of President (CHN F. KENNEDY), and in the letter WISENG alleged a "friend" of his recently found a spent, practically intact, bullet in a planter on Houston Street near the KEWHEDY Memorial in Dallas. WISBIRG indicated in his letter he suspected this reported discovery was a plant, but wanted to call this to the attention of the Sureau and offered to make the bullet available for examination by the FBI Laboratory if such was desired.

MR. SIRCOER stated he desired you or SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING to call him or the Division Whicht Supervisor, back 12/8/70, and advise whether such a reported discovery had come to the attention of the Dallas Office or the Dallas PD. He stated, however, no direct inquiry concerning this should be made of the Dallas FD. When advised that you were tied up on an on scene investigative matter, MR. SHRODER stated SA GERENLING should be queried concerning this. He said a return phone call regarding his inquiry would be sufficient and no written reply would be necessary unless we had knowledge of WISBIRG alleged discovery.

I contacted SA GEMBERLING at the Lubbock RA, apprised him of the above, and he stated no such information has been reported to this office, nor do we have any knowledge any such information has come to the attention of the Dallas PD. SA GEMBERLIT said he was confident that had the Dallas PD received such a report they would have brought it to our attention.
