The report also concludes that O:wald acted alone and had no connection with Jack Leon Ruby, the 52-year-old night club operator who shot thim on November 24 in the basement of Dallas Police Headquarters.

Ballistics Comparison

Included in the report is the ballistics comparison that the fatal shots fired at President Kennedy came from the gun Oswald bought under an assumed name.

Officials close to the investigation said the report actually contains little that already has not been made public about the tragedy. However, it is reportedly accompanied by photographs and other exhibits of evidence that have not been seen by the public,

It also disclosed yesterday that the FBI gave a routine "risk list" of Dallss area residents to the Secret Service in advance of the President illfated trip to the city where he met his death, but the list did not contain the name of Oswald.

Oswald's presence in the Dalcas area was known to the FBI, which had talked to him in New Orleans on August 1 after Oswald was involved in some pro-Castro activity.
