I called Mr. Walter Jenkins at the White House and told him I had just talked with the President. I said I wondered if the President would like to use my armored car; that I would be very happy indeed if he would allow me to send to him for his use the armored car I have until it can be determined if the Secret Service wants to buy an armored car for him. I told Mr. Jenkins the car is a Cadillac limousine and looks like any other limousine, that you couldn't tell the difference.

Mr. Jenkins said he would have to talk to the President about this. I told him, if the President would like to use the armored car, I can make it available right away.
