The enclosed documents are from the Federal Bureau of Investigation file pertaining to the investigation of the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. With the exception of those documents previously released to you, these are the only FBI documents pertaining to you which are readily retrievable through a routine records search.

If you should desire a search of the entire file pertaining to Dr. King's assassination, an approximate 48,000 pages, for any references to either of you, search fees will be assessed at the rate of \$1.00 for each quarter hour in excess of the first quarter hour. The first fifteen minutes of a search is provided without cost. It is estimated that the time involved in conducting such a search would be approximately 60 days. This would result in a total cost to you of \$1,920. Before initiating such a search, we would require 25 percent of this amount in advance. If it is your desire to have such a search conducted, please forward a check or money order in the amount of \$480, made payable to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

These documents are available for your review without cost at FBI Headquarters. Arrangements to review the documents should be made 24 hours in advance by contacting SA Edward L. Grimsley at telephone number 324-3764.
