Treasury Informant

PHILADELPHIA—Roy Frankhouser, a self-proclaimed Nazi, Ku Klux Klansman and Minuteman, was used briefly as an informer by the Treasury Department to try to penetrate a Black September group in Canada, according to a story in the Philadelphia Inquirer.

The Inquirer said Frankhouser, 35, of Reading, Pa., was to gather information on illegal trafficking in guns and explosives by extremist groups in 'canada.

The paper said that when Frank houser's efforts failed to produce dramatic results, the government decided to prosecute him in connection with dynmaite thefts from a Reading firm in 1973. Frankhouser goes on trial Sept. 16.
