

3/11/69 FBI visits in N.O. about me.

Matt Herron phoned a little after 11 to say that on several recent occasions as many as three men identifying themselves as from the FBI visited Dione and her parents to say that I am an associate of Communists and that they should stay away from me. They were to return at 10 o'clock New Orleans time today. They also asked Dione if she knew Dean Andrews and she replied she had seen him recently. She is Matt's source, having ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ phoned him this morning. They told her that the reason Garrison did what he had is because people like me, again with Communist emphasis, kept going down there and steaming him up. The import is that he did not take the initiative and that I (we) did.

It is Matt's opinion that they may be about to start something, now that the trial is over.

C From what he said it is possible to deduce that Dione is the one who introduced my name. Perhaps listening to the tape would establish this. In any event, if her story is true and if she did introduce my name, they seem to have had things to say about me, seem to have looked into me.

She promised to get in touch with him after today's visit. I asked him to ask her to get the names.

O I also phoned Larry Stern, National editor of the Washington Post, and told him. I later mentioned it to Bill Mick.
