For spectro/MAA appeal or resand. Source FMIHA #105-82555-4584, the report of Robert P. Genberling dated 8/5/64 ocvering the investigative period 6/10-7/31/64.

Conclusory and the other irrelevants It has two subboadings, one/animukynkreskewstraadzinexstraarge "A. <u>Amenanin in Building</u>" and "B. <u>Ratrolean Timet Killed</u>."(As related to the **Right** Mining mesasoination connecting the Tippit Rilling also is conclusory.)

"assassin in Building"is of but two short paragrpahe. The second does not relate to facts of the crime. It is an gefaithful account of what unnamed and unidentified witnesses are represented as having seen.

All there is in five fancy bound volumes on the orine itself is:

"As the motorcade was travelling through downtown Dallas on Him Street about 50 yards firms wost of the intersection with Houston (Exhibit 1) three shots rang out. Two bullets struck President Hennedy, and one wounded Governor Connally." (The rest of the paragraph is not on the origet "The President, who slupped forward in the car, was rushed to Parkland Henorial Hospital, where he was pronounced deed at troes.")

With attention this is a blockbuster.

Table of contents shows that pp. 27-39 are on this investigation. The last words of the entry are "and Struck JIN TAGUE."

Jin's name is mantioned one time, as the appropriate page of the index shows. (186) He is on 27. The entire page is a subhead, word-for-word the language of the table of contents. There is no other monthins of Tabus.

Although the FBI avoided the two Dullas photographers, Underwoodand Dillard, for almost mine souths, both state there was a Visible mark. Their FD302s, not their words but these of FBI agents seeking to play it down, are included.
