PHOENIX, Ariz., Nov. 19 (UPI)—FBI Director Clarence M. Kelley has been subpoenaed to appear in connection with a case involving a self-avowed Socialist fighting to regain the teaching job he lost at Arizona State University in 1970.

Roger Young, assistant agent incharge of the Phoenix office of the FBI, said he accepted the subpoena Thursday on behalf of Kelley, who was here to address a civic luncheon.

The subpoena orders Kelley to appear Dec. 13 in the case involving Morris Starsky, fired as an associate professor of philosophy for miscon-

Starsky has asserted that the FBI mailed an anonymous letter to members of an ASU faculty committee considering disciplinary action against him. Starsky said the letter was a fabrication and slanderous.
