

Justice Finds No FBI Link to King Death

Justice Department lawyers have found no evidence of FBI involvement in the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and are satisfied that the FBI's investigation of King's death was handled "thoroughly and efficiently," informed sources report.

The assessment was based on a review of the FBI's voluminous file on the black civil rights leader.

The findings and possibly a recommendation for a full-scale probe of the FBI's harassment campaign of King are expected to be turned over to Atty. Gen. Edward H. Levi soon. Levi ordered the inquiry last November following disclosures by the Senate Intelligence Committee that the FBI sought to destroy King as a leader.
