SUBJECT: LEE HARVEY OSWALD
ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT

Enclosed is a scrapbook in the French language which was transmitted to the President by Mr. Paul Orlyue, 112 Avenue du General Leclerc, Boulogne-Billancourt (Seine), France. The communication was referred to the Department of State and an acknowledgement has been made to Mr. Orlyue.

In transmitting this material to the Bureau, State included the translator's summary of the communication which is characterized as the writer's "report" on the Kennedy assassination. The writer believes that Oswald was the victim of a plot and that the real assassin is James Hidell, "who looks like him." The writer sends this "report" to help the FBI.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Translation Section of the Laboratory review the enclosed document so that the General Investigative Division will have a better idea if any further action is required.
