

On 1-31-64 Mr. Eisenberg of the President's Commission contacted Mr. R. H. Jevons and requested that all physical evidence now in possession of our field offices be sent to the Bureau to be available to the Commission when needed. This info was telephonically furnished SAC Shanklin, Dallas, by Supervisor R. E. Lenihan and Mr. Shanklin indicated DL will comply but that it would be an extremely difficult research problem for DL to alert auxiliary offices which might possess evidence this case. Supervisor Lenihan then informed Shanklin that Shanklin should confine himself to submitting evidence maintained by DL and that the Bureau would notify all other offices of the Commission's desires.
