These cartridges will be retained by us until such time as a decision is reached as to the disposition to be made of the physical evidence collected in connection with our investigation of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

NOTE:

The two cartridges in question (30.06 caliber) have nothing to do with the assassination. They were obtained from an OC lawyer at the specific request of the Commission and were forwarded to the Commission with an OC Letterhead 7/31/64 which, together with the cartridges, was assigned Commission Document Number 1355. Both the letterhead and the bullets were turned over to the Archives by the Commission. The Deputy Archivist, on 9/13/65, wrote to the Department and asked if it would be possible for the Department to retain them. The OC letterhead is among those documents which can be made available for public review. However, it would be unwise to include with the letterhead two live cartridges which may be dangerous. The cartridges were picked up from the Archives 9/29/65 by SA K. M. Raupach and are being retained in the Lab with other exhibits.
