The two cartridges in question (30.06 caliber) have nothing to do with the assassination. They were obtained from an OC lawyer at the specific request of the Connicsion and were forwarded to the Commission with an OC Letterhead 37/31/64 which, together with the cartridges, was assigned Commission Document Number 1355. Both the letterhead and the bullets were turned over to the Archives by the Commission. The Deputy Archivist, on 9/13/65, wrote to the Department and asked if it would be possible for the Department to retain them. The OC letterhead is among those documents which can be made available for public review. However, it would be unwise to include with the letterbead two live cartridges which may be dangerous. The cartridges were picked up from the Archives 9/29/65 by SA K. M. Raupach and are being rotained in the Lab with other exhibits.
