DAVIS SUBSEQUENTLY OBTAINED FILM AT DALLAS POLICE DEPARTMENT AND HAD TWO COPIES OF FILM AND THREE HARD COPY PRINTS MADE OF EACH PHOTOGRAPH IN FILM, AT RECORDAK COMPANY, DALLAS. SOMETIME IN JUNE ALEXANDER BROUGHT WADE A PACKAGE CONTAINING ONE SET OF HARD COPY PHOTOGRAPHS AND ADVISED WADE, "THIS IS YOUR COPY." COPY WAS WRAPPED IN MANILA PAPER AND WAS THEREAFTER STOKED IN WADE'S LOCKED CABINET. REMAINING ITEMS AND COPIES KEPT IN ALEXANDER'S CUSTODY.
