Attempt to Steal FBI Documents Fails in N. Y.

NEW YORK (AP). — The New York Times says a group calling itself "People's Bureau of Investigation" has claimed it attempted to burglarize the FBI's office in Garden City on Long Island.

The FBI, the Times said, acknowledged a burglary attempt had been made but declined further comment.

The Times said a visit to the building showed new plaster patches on a wall separating a corridor from the FBI offices.

The Times said an anonymous call came to the paper Monday from a woman who said the attempt to steal documents was made Sunday night.

She said it was "aborted when someone unexpectedly entered the building," the Times said.

There was no indication whether the "People's Bureau of Investigation" had any connection with the "Citizens Commission to Investigate the FBI," involved in the successful burglary of an FBI office in Media, Pa.
