Scouts Deny 'Eyes, Ears' Story

NEW BRUNSWICK, N. J. (UPI). — The national headquarters of the Boy Scouts of America here has denied that 1,000 Boy Scouts in Rochester, N. Y., had been asked to help serve as "eyes and ears"

of the Police Department.

A document reportedly stolen from FBI files in Media, Pa., was circulated in Philadelphia by the American Friends Service Committee describing surveillance activi-

ties being carried by Rochester Boy Scouts.

However, Scout officials said all the Scouts were asked to do was exercise the same surveillance activities required of any American citizen.
