The FBI's present attitude toward Communists and the New Left was described in an annual report for the fiscal year which ended last June 30. The report was distributed last week.

The FBI said the number of Soviet-bloc personnel residing in the United States has increased by 44 per cent in the past five years.

These include embassy workers and others on various semi-official missions and, with their families, total 2,686, the FBI said.

"FBI counter-intelligence operations continue to identify a high and fairly consistent percentage of Soviet-bloc personnel in the United States as intelligence officers agents," the report "Accordingly, the threat to the United States and the counterintelligence responsibilities of the FBI have been growing in proportion to the Soviet-bloc
