

**Kelley Promotes 3 NY

Washington, Sept. 4 (UPI) — FBI Director Clarence Kelley announced the promotion today of three of his agents to high administrative and financial positions in the bureau.

Kelley said that John J. McDermott, 50, a native of New York City and a member of the bureau for 25 years, had been named acting assistant to the director, and deputy associate director for administration.

Kelley said also that Richard E. Long, special agent in charge of the Phoenix office, had been promoted to acting assistant director of the FBI's finance and personnel division.

Charles A. Donelan of the FBI's legal office was named acting assistant director in charge of the bureau's training division, Kelley said.
