Griffin Bell's Diary: From White House To FBI Steambath Port 2/1/2/77 United Press International

Attorney General Griffin Bell's log of telephone calls and meetings chronicles virtually every move, from meetings with the President to sessions in the FBI steambath.

The logs, made public Monday by the Justice Department, showed Bell keeps in frequent touch with President Carter, but "makes far more contacts with members of Congress.

Bell said Sunday on CBS-TV "Face the Nation" that "for every time I've talked to the President, I've talked 20 times to senators." The log indicated that has been true.

The log also contained this entry dated Feb. 3: "6:00—To FBI steambath (Donald Moore)." Moore is an FBI official.
