Californian Kills 3 Turks And Is Slain

ISTANBUL, Dec. 28 (UPI)—
A long-haired Californian with
a pair of pistols shot and
killed at least three persons,
then held off hundreds of police
in a four-hour gun battle
seen by thousands in downtown
Istanbul today.

The man was finally slain
and his body plunged down an
elevator shaft. A girl with him
surrendered, apparently un-
harmd. At least four persons
were wounded, including a police
superintendent.

The gunman, identified as
Gary Ralph Bouldin, 33, of
San Jose, Calif., and his com-
panion, Patricia Ann Seeds,
20, of Berkeley, Calif., were
stopped by a traffic police-
man. Police said they sus-
pected Bouldin of smuggling,
but did not say of what.

When Bouldin would not
show a proof of his car's own-
ership, the officer told him he
would have to accompany a
detective to headquarters. As
the detective led the pair into
a police office, Bouldin pulled
a gun and fatally shot him.

Bouldin and Miss Seeds
then ran into a nearby restau-
rant, where he killed a ware-
houseman and an official of
the Turkish Maritime Bank,
and up to a rooftop room. Two
U. S. FBI men with subma-
chine guns participated in the
ensuing gun battle.
