Dear Howard,

I did some checking on Lane's two FOIA suits a couple of days ago. Both were voluntarily dismissed by Lane's attorneys, the ACLU (John Shattuck). The record in both cases is skimpy. Neither side did much in the way of work. However, in Lane v. Secret Service, et al., Civil Action No. 76-0227, Pratt, J., Lane did get the Secret Service to cough up an inventory of certain records before Lane entered a dismissal. The inventory is 55 pages long. I am enclosing 5 pages which I had copied after a very hasty examination. They may have some pertinence to your attempts to get Harold's correspondence on the Memorandum of Transfer.

I will contact the Secret Service and see if I can get them to send me a copy of the inventory, and you might want to do likewise. The cost of copying it at the court at 25 cents a page is prohibitive.
