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KENNEDY - OSHALD 3 WASHINGTON

THE DEODORANT AND THE KIPPER RECIPES ARE INCLUDED IN THE LIST OF OSWALD'S PERSONAL EFFECTS SENT TO THE FBI HEADQUARTERS FROM DALLAS.

As an example of the immense; and often apparently meaningless effort; the FBI put in to the probe is the case of the railroad boxcar.

THE AGENCY'S DETROIT BUREAU FOUND A HOODEN-SIDED RAILWAY FREIGHT HAGON WITH THE WORDS "LEE OSWALD DALLAS; TEXAS FUTURE MAN OF DESTINY APR. 4 1963" HRITTEN IN YELLOW CHALK ON THE INSIDE.

IT SENT 12 SAMPLES OF THE CHALK TO WASHINGTON FOR ANALYSIS TO SEE HOW RECENT THE INSCRIPTION WAS AND IF IT WAS THE SAME CHALK THAT DREW A DIAGRAM OF THO INTERTWINED TRIANGLES ON ANOTHER WALL OF THE BOXCAR.

THE LABORATORY'S FINDINGS MAY BE IN THE FILES SOMEWHERE;
BUT THEY WEREN'T ANYWHERE NEAR THE DETROIT BUREAU'S REPORT.

IN AN ACT OF IRONY; THE FILES ALSO SHOW THAT USWALD; WHILE IN RUSSIA IN 1961; WROTE TO THEN NAVY SECRETARY JOHN CONNALLY DEMANDING THAT THE "GROSS INJUSTICE", DONE TO HIM BY HIS DISHONORABLE DISCHARGE FROM THE MARINES BE RECTIFIED.

OSWALD; ON RESERVE STATUS AT THE TIME; WAS DISHONORABLY DISCHARGED IN AUGUST; 1960; AFTER HIS DEFECTION TO THE SOVIET UNION.

Mr. Connally, by then Governor of Texas, has hounded by Oshald's shots as he rode alongside President Kennedy.

One early report in the Oshald file that he frequently drank to excess and beat his hife apparently fascinated the FBI and is repeated on numerous occasions throughout the file.

Oshald's belief that life had dealt him an injustice has not entirely unfounded. While in the Marines, a bureaucratic error classified him as "Marksman" while his score qualified him for the superior "Sharpshooter" rating -- a fact only uncovered after his death.
