HOLMES WAS ASSISTED IN THE INTERECGATION BY DALLAS POLICE CAPTAIN WILL FRITZ WITH FRI AND SECRET SERVICE AGENTS PRESENT.

"HE DIDN'T LIKE THE OFF THEY HANDED RIM AND INSISTED ON PUTTING ON A BLACK SLIP-OVER SWEATER THAT HAD SOME JAGGED HOLES MEAR THE FRONT OF THE RIGHT SHOULDER," ACLMES SAID.

DUPLING THE QUESTIGNING, HOLMES YAID, GSWALD EMPHATICALLY DENIED HAVING ANY KNOWLEDGE OF THE KERNEDY SHOOTING, AND SAID HE WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY JUST BECAUSE HE HAD "POPPED A POLICEMAN IN THE MOSE IN A THEATER ON JEFFERSON AVENUE" DURING HIS CAPTURE.

"HID DENIED THAT HE HAD EVER ORDERED ANY RIFLE BY MAIL ORDER OR BOUGHT ANY MOMEY ORDER FOR THE PURPLES OF PAYING FOR SUCH A RIFLE," HOLMES WROTE. "IN FACT, HE CLAIMED HE OWNED NO RIFLE AND HAD NOT PRACTICED OR SHOT A RIFLE OTHER THAN POSSIBLY A .22, SMALL BORE RIFL! SINCE HIS DAYS WITH THE MAINE CORPS.
