Re:Untold stories of FBI files:

Despite the negative attitudes of national press and TV covering the opening of the FBI files, there is incredible information hidden in the files:

For example:

1. Two weeks before their killing, as a result of a dinner between a group of people in Houston, the FBI special agent was given a warning that he must tell Mashington that "JFK would never get out of Texas", that three oilmen had got together to arrange his assassination, and that this was not idle talk - it was a very serious threat.... nothing appears to have been done.

2. Two days main before assassination, Dd las police told FBI later, they had seen two men sighting rigles at silhoutte targets in back of an old car bezing driven through Dealey Plaza...they gave chase, were unable to catch men.

3.Billy <sup>G</sup>raham said over radio that proor to assassination he had been contacted by GOV Connally to use all his influence to stop JFK going to Manhhama exas because of danger to his life...he said that he did so.

4. Hours after Lee Harvey Oswals was arrested, the lawyer for mafia boss Sam Gianaana -since linked with Castro death attempts twice tried unsuccessfully to get in touch with Odwald.

5.Commander Humes, man who conducted autopsy on JFK, said he believed another bullet hit Connally on municumwrist - shattering Warren Commiss. findings...also condiserable additional evidence, not before revealed, of additional bullet g fragments, again shattering the lone assassin findings.

6.FBI received an anonymous call, which they treated seriously, saying Oswald was about to be killed, a couple of hours before it happened...they passed this on to Dallas cops, etc.

7. Scared witness told FBI that Parkland Hospital was put on alert by Dallas police hour before Oswald killed, told to expect an emergency shortly...witness says because they knew Oswald bout to be killed.

8.Dal las cops do close to Ruby, that when his sister visited Dallas they sent cop car to airport to meet her, then drove her on tour of town....another witness confirms that 150 Dallas cops regulars as drinking pals of Ruby ....shattering the Warren Commiss finding that never close ties between cops and Ruby. FBI, Secret Service, and Naval Intelligence (don't know why latter) were all conducting intensive probe of a Mormon mm in Da las (prior to killing) because he was regarded as being so dangerous.... this man is now on run for killing Mormon polygamists....

10: FBI experts themselves described the 'one bullet theory' so important to Warren Commiss. findings, as "wild".

I would propose to get to as many of the people mentioned in the FBI files as witnesses, as possible, to flesh out incidents which are rather thin in FBI files....plus, getting to experts to

Memo to Mr. Belmont from Rosen Re: Assassination of President

During this session Commander James J. Humes advanced the theory. that the first shot entered the President's body in the rear in the neck region , 3 a few indues below the head and followed a pattern through the neck and exited . in the front without encountering any bone or other objects which slowed the bullet to any degree. Commander Humes was of the opinion the bullet continued . and struck Governor Connelly in the back on the right-hand side below the shoulder and exited on the right-hand side of Governor Connelley in the chest area. Commander Humes stated that here again, based on medical reports received from doctors in Texas who examined Governor Connellsy, the bullet met with no serious obstruction and passed through the body, merely grazing one of the rib bones. It was Commander Humes' opinion that the bullet from the first shot apparently lodged in some manner in the clothing of Governor Connelley and this bullet is: the one which was found on the stretcher on which Governor Connelley was brought to Parkland Hospital in Dallas, Texas. Commander Humes states this bullet was not damaged in any way and it is for this reason he feels that the first shot definitely passed through both the body of the President and Governor Connelley.

In explaining his feelings concerning this theory, Commander Humes stated that another shot is believed to have hit the right wrist of Governor Connelley with such an impact that it caused the bullet to break into many fragments and he noted that many fragments were found in the right wrist area of Governor Connelley as well as in the thigh of the left leg.

Relative to the third shot which was fired, which based on the photographic material available is believed to be the one which hit the President's head, Commander Humes ad ised that there is no question that this bullet separated into many fragments upon impact and many fragments were found in the skull area of the President. He noted that one fragment had apparently struck the front windshield from the inside inasmuch as the examination of the windshield did detect some lead deposit where an object had struck the inside of the windshield. Commander Humes states that the fragment which struck the windshield could have been from this shot w hich struck the President's head or could have been a fragment from the shot which hit Governor Connelly's wrist.

The other doctors present did not completely confirm the theory of Commander Humes but felt, based on their review of the pictures, noting the movements of Gavernor Connolly in the President's automobile and the general location of the occupants in the car, that there was a possibility this theory was correct. It is noted that any comments made in the past by the Burgau relative to the shots that struck the President and Governor Connelly were based completely on medical reports furnished the Burgau by Doctors at Parkland Hospital and the results of the autopsy of the U.S. Naval Hospital, Bethesda, Marylan-
