

Ex-FBI Man Hits Rowe Testimony

RICHMOND (AP) — A former bodyguard for Gary T. Rowe Jr., who infiltrated the Ku Klux Klan for the FBI, says he doesn't believe Rowe's testimony before the Senate Intelligence Committee.

James P. Morgan, an FBI agent for five years and now an assistant professor at Virginia Commonwealth University, said in an interview he watched Rowe's Senate testimony on television last week and found himself saying, "Come on, Gary, that's just not right."

Rowe was a member of the Alabama Ku Klux Klan working as an FBI undercover agent from 1960 to 1965.
