Writer received call on above date from SA HARVEY JAMES, WFO, who advised as follows:

Two manila envelopes, one addressed to FBI, Los Angeles and the other to FBI, San Diego, had been placed on board, in custody of the captain, of Flight American Airlines Flight 29 leaving Baltimore 11:40 PM, EST arriving Los Angeles International 1:45 AM, Los Angeles time. Envelopes contain photographs of the inside of the motel where KING murder suspect stayed in Memphis and of items of evidence obtained from room.

Stated that agent meeting above flight will have to make arrangements for the San Diego envelope to be placed on board appropriate flight for San Diego and that San Diego be called so an agent could meet the plane there also.

Writer contacted SA BARRY, Airport Detail of Inglewood RA and he stated he would handle. Stated that he would contact the office and advise what flight he had placed the San Diego envelope on so that this info could be phoned down to SD in time for plane to be met.

2 - LA SA BARRY called advising he gave SD's envelope to Senior JCW/mc Stewardess First Class C. K. BANDY, United Flight 219, departing Los Angeles 5:30 A.M., 4/9/68 and arriving San Diego 6:02 A.M.

At 3:43 A.M., 4/9/68 SA H. R. McCULLOUGH telephonically advised the Night Clerk, FBI, San Diego, who indicated he would call their ASAC to have him designate an SA to pick up their envelope.
