

**Mondale Says Panel Seeks
F.B.I. 'Assassination File'**

WASHINGTON, May 16 (UPI)

—The Senate Select Committee on Intelligence Activities has asked the Justice Department to turn over a previously undisclosed "assassination file" of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, according to Senator Walter F. Mondale, Democrat of Minnesota.

Senator Mondale, a member of the committee, said Sunday on the CBS Television program "Face the Nation" that the intelligence agencies had generally been "quite forthcoming" about providing material on their secret operations.

But, Mr. Mondale said, "There is some evidence we haven't seen everything." He said that committee staff members had come across an F.B.I. file with an assassination heading while working on an investigation of

the assassination of President Kennedy.

"It was apparently labeled 'Assassination: Mr. Castro,' or something like that," Mr. Mondale said.
