'Assassination File'

The FBI has belatedly discovered an "assassination file" regarding attempts of, the life of Cuban Premier Fidel Castro, according to Sen. Walter F. Mondale (D-Minn.).

An FBI spokesman refused to comment beyond stating that the file would be furnished soon to the Senate intelligence committee. Mondale, a committee member, said Sunday on "Face the Nation" (CBS, WTOP) that the committee had asked the FBI months ago "for all files relating" to assassinations, and recently discovered a cross-reference to the new file in other documents it received.
