Court Dismisses Weisberg's Suit

A suit filed by Harold Weisberg against the United States government, under the Freedom of Information Law 5 USC 552, in which Weisberg demanded copies of information pertinent to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy for his permanent use, has been dismissed.

Dismissal came, according to Weisberg, when the government told the court that it would allow him to view copies of the desired information under govern-

ment supervision.

According to Weisberg, the government informed the court that a contract prevented them from preparing copies of the material for a person's permanent use but that copies could be made and viewed under government supervision.

According to Weisberg, he charged "that the government misrepresented fact, regulation and law in an effort to withhold information that I felt that they should not be able to withhold."
